FAMILY AND FRIENDS OF HAWAI'I FOODBANK,

It is my honor to share Hawai'i Foodbank's 2022 Annual Report with you. For nearly 40 years, Hawai'i Foodbank has been synonymous with getting food in the hands of those in need. We believe that consistent access to safe and healthy food is a fundamental human right, and the Foodbank has been working to ensure that no one goes hungry in our communities for almost four decades now.

However, Hawai'i Foodbank isn't just about food. Hawai'i Foodbank is about people. The people we serve are at the center of all that we do, and our mission goes far beyond putting food on the table. Food means so much more than fulfilling a basic need. Food connects us to family, celebrates our island cultures and is essential to thriving communities.

With that in mind, I'm pleased to share our newly expanded mission statement: to nourish our 'ohana today while we work to end hunger tomorrow. This encapsulates our core work of meeting the daily food assistance needs of our communities while unequivocally emphasizing our work to end hunger in Hawai'i. It recognizes the journey the Foodbank has been on for the last four decades, and it also points to how we hope to elevate our work in the years ahead.

In 2022, hunger was closer to a lot of us than we might realize. With the aftermath of the pandemic – which doubled food insecurity levels and strained all aspects of our organization's operations – and record inflation rates, 1 in 6 people in Hawai'i continue to struggle with hunger. Food insecurity impacts our neighbors, our friends, our family, our keiki, our kūpuna and many more. To meet this persistent need, we have stepped up our operations – with a focus on establishing a new baseline post-pandemic, building upon the lessons of the past year and integrating best practices throughout the organization. In these pages, you'll read how we are broadening our reach by building capacity, strengthening support to our partner networks, pursuing advocacy and outreach opportunities, purchasing more food, and, most importantly, building connections.

We've been able to do this because of the incredible support of our community and people like you. Mahalo for your trust and partnership. Your generosity fuels our vision towards a future where every person in Hawai'i has access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food all year round. Together, we can make this vision a reality.

ABOUT HAWAI‘I FOODBANK

Hawai‘i Foodbank is a nonprofit 501(c)3 organization that provides food assistance to the State of Hawai‘i. As Hawai‘i’s largest hunger-relief organization, we distributed more than **17.4 million pounds of food**, including **4.6 million pounds of fresh produce**, on O‘ahu and Kaua‘i in 2022.

Hawai‘i Foodbank serves O‘ahu and Kaua‘i directly while partnering with **Maui Food Bank** to serve Maui County and **The Food Basket** to serve Hawai‘i Island. Together, we serve the daily needs of our communities, increase access to safe and nutritious food, and advocate for policy change. **Together, we are working to end hunger across Hawai‘i.**

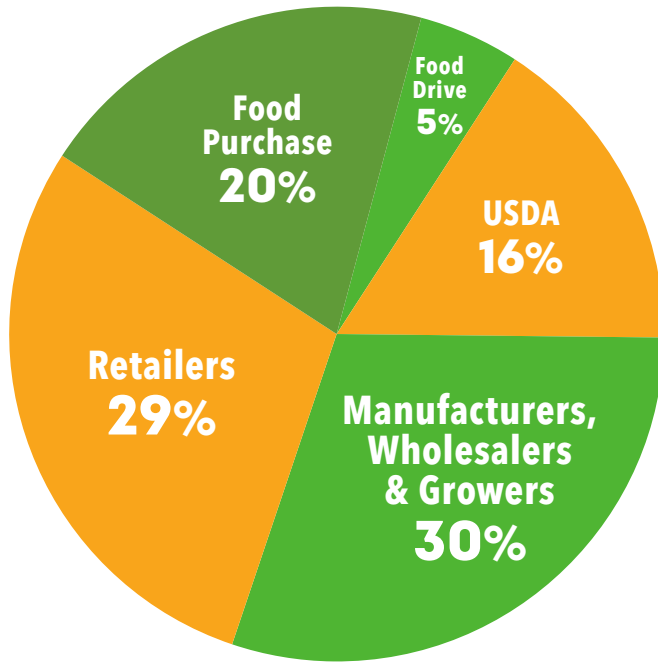
Working Together to **END HUNGER IN HAWAI‘I**



Hawai‘i Foodbank is a certified partner of **Feeding America** – the nation’s largest hunger-relief organization, encompassing a network of 200 food banks across the United States. Certification means Hawai‘i Foodbank is held to the highest standards for food handling, storage and distribution, financial management, organizational stability, board governance and more.

Hawai‘i Foodbank is also a proud agency partner of **Aloha United Way** and **Kaua‘i United Way**.

FLOW OF FOOD



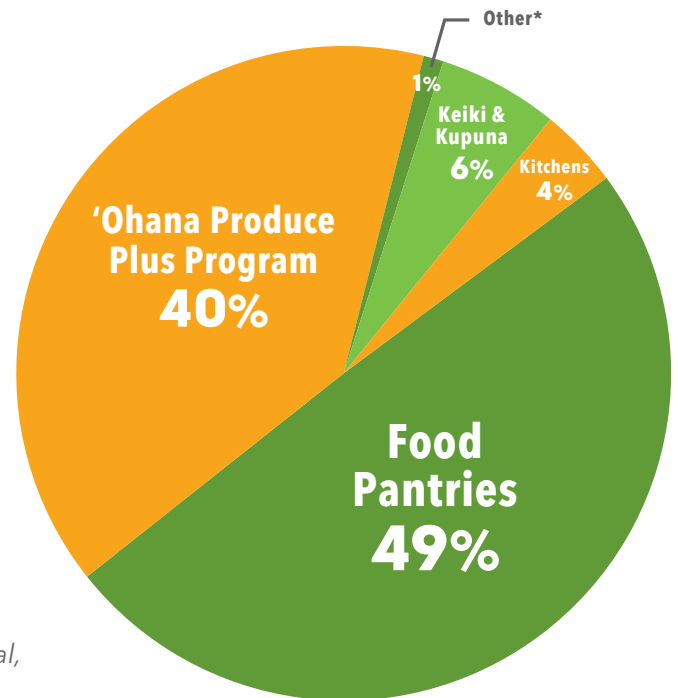
SOURCES OF FOOD

Hawai'i Foodbank operates out of two locations: our 23,668 square-foot warehouse on O'ahu and our 4,750 square-foot warehouse on Kaua'i. Both warehouses are AIB inspected and certified for food safety. In our warehouses, we receive, inspect, sort, inventory, store, and distribute perishable and nonperishable food.

We receive food from food manufacturers, farmers and growers, food purchases, food retailers and wholesalers, Feeding America and other food bank partners, individual and corporate food drives, federal food commodities, and other supporters.

DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD

Hawai'i Foodbank partners with food pantries, homeless shelters, soup kitchens, domestic abuse shelters, rehabilitation centers and others to distribute food through feeding programs like the following: 'Ohana Produce Plus, multiple Food 4 Keiki programs, Kūpuna Fresh, the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program and the Senior Food Box Program.



** This includes neighbor islands; shelters; and residential, rehabilitation, pet, hygiene and other relief programs.*



HUNGER *touches* EVERYONE

This includes parents like Janice, a hard-working mother of two who says that providing her family with healthy food is “everything.”

With the high cost of living, programs like Food 4 Keiki and 'Ohana Produce Plus help fill the gap in nutrition when she isn't able to afford the food at the grocery store that her keiki need.

Janice loves cooking for her daughter Jaida, whose favorite meal is tacos. Janice looks forward to loading up the dish with the vegetables and meat from the distributions.

The Persistent **NEED**

Hunger is persistent and unyielding. The number of Hawai'i residents facing **hunger remains 50% higher** than before the pandemic. This means **1 in 6 Hawai'i residents** will experience hunger this year, including **1 in 4 keiki** – the second highest rate of child food insecurity in the nation.

Due to record rates of inflation, many individuals and families in Hawai'i continue to find themselves having to make impossible choices between food and other basic necessities. This means opting for cheaper, unhealthier food

options and skipping meals. To get by, many even forego essential needs like housing, medicine, utilities, education and transportation.

Hawai'i Foodbank is here to help. We work closely with our **network of 200 agency partners** to ensure the communities we serve have access to the nourishment we all need. Last year, we distributed food for more than **14.5 million meals** while serving an average of more than **120,000 people each month**.

NOURISH



'OHANA PRODUCE PLUS

For more than 20 years, Hawai'i Foodbank and participating agency partners have distributed millions of pounds of fresh produce, assorted dry goods and nonperishable food items to underserved communities through the 'Ohana Produce Plus program. Recipients of this program include families with low income, people with disabilities, houseless individuals and more. For many people, **'Ohana Produce Plus is their only source of fresh fruits and vegetables.**

Last year, Hawai'i Foodbank worked with 47 agency partners on O'ahu and Kaua'i to distribute more than 2.8 million pounds of fresh produce and 3.6 million pounds of baked goods, dairy, eggs, cereal, snacks, beverages, canned goods and other items.

SCHOOL PANTRY PROGRAM

The Food 4 Keiki School Pantry program serves as a **critical food resource for students of all ages, their siblings and their families.** The School Pantries provide healthy snacks for students during the day, as well as the opportunity to take a bag of food home to their families for the weekend. Bags are filled with canned proteins, canned meals, dry goods, snacks and more.

Last year, our School Pantry program expanded to 37 sites on O'ahu and Kaua'i. The program distributed nearly 220,000 pounds of food to more than 26,000 students and their families throughout the 2021-2022 school year.

SUMMER MEALS PROGRAM & FEEDING OUR FUTURE

Last year, Hawai'i Foodbank piloted its first Summer Meals Program, also known as the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). This Federal Child Nutrition program was launched alongside the already established Feeding Our Future summer lunch program. Both summer programs **provide students with hot meals and snacks during a critical time when they don't have access to their regular school meals.**

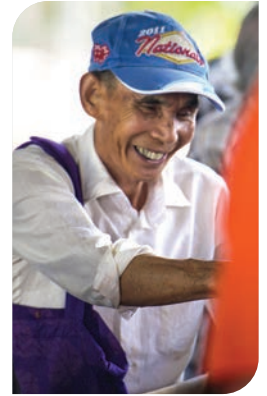
Together, the Summer Meals Program and Feeding Our Future distributed more than 4,200 meals and 1,000 snacks last summer. Through a total of eight different sites, Hawai'i Foodbank provided summer food to more than 700 students.

Our 'Ohana

SENIOR FOOD BOX PROGRAM

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program, otherwise known as the Senior Food Box Program, **distributes food boxes to improve the health and well-being of seniors with low income.** Boxes contain supplemental foods such as non-fat dry milk, cheese, cereal, juice, peanut butter, rice, canned meat, fruits, vegetables and more. This program is provided in partnership with the State of Hawai'i and the Office of Community Services.

Last year, the Senior Food Box Program served 2,005 qualified seniors. Throughout the year, more than 24,000 senior food boxes were distributed on O'ahu and Kaua'i.



SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program **provides low-income seniors with greater access to fresh fruits and vegetables.** Program participants can redeem vouchers for items like fresh produce, herbs and honey at participating farmers' market vendors. This program is provided in partnership with the State of Hawai'i and the Office of Community Services.

From April to October 2022, the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program served nearly 6,500 certified participants on O'ahu and Kaua'i. Each senior received \$50 worth of vouchers.





Our Vision IN ACTION

At Hawai'i Foodbank, we believe that consistent, equitable access to safe and healthy food is a fundamental human right. We also believe that food is more than a basic need. Food provides so much more than just nourishment; it is a way for people to connect. This holds especially true in Hawai'i – where food connects us to family, celebrates our island cultures and is essential to thriving communities. Rooted in these beliefs, **we envision a future where all in Hawai'i have access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food all year round.**

EXPANDING OUR IMPACT

Our partners and supporters are instrumental to the work we are doing. It is because of these collaborative relationships that we have been able to expand our services to provide more nutritious and culturally meaningful options for our community while also establishing new initiatives that address the systemic reasons people need our services. Here are some highlights from last year:

FARM TO FOODBANK: Hawai'i Foodbank continued its work to directly support local farmers, expanding its Farm to Foodbank produce purchase program on O'ahu while also launching the initiative on Kaua'i. Last year, the program **distributed nearly 2 million pounds of fresh, local produce** between both islands, including culturally important foods such as poi, 'uala and 'ulu. As a result of this program, Hawai'i Foodbank was named Outstanding Friend of Farmer by the Hawai'i Farm Bureau in recognition of its commitment to local farmers and producers.

KŪPUNA FRESH: The Kūpuna Fresh program continued to operate in conjunction with the Senior Food Box Program in order to provide more fresh fruits and vegetables to seniors in need of food assistance. Kūpuna Fresh **provided nearly 700 seniors with nutritious, locally sourced produce** at eight locations on O'ahu and one new location on Kaua'i.

AGENCY PARTNER SUPPORT: To help eliminate barriers and build a more equitable distribution model, the Foodbank **eliminated shared maintenance fees on all donated foods** in April 2022. A standard practice at many food banks, agency partners typically pay shared maintenance fees to help with the cost of food storage, transportation, distribution and more. Eliminating this fee will allow our agency partners to concentrate their funds on their own programs.

SNAP OUTREACH: The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) helps put nutritious food on the tables of families and individuals in need of support, and every SNAP dollar can help provide five meals. In 2022, **Hawai'i Foodbank secured funding to launch its SNAP Outreach Program.** Through the program, we hope to help raise awareness about SNAP; reduce stigma and confusion about the system; offer direct SNAP prescreening, application and recertification assistance; and link our neighbors to other resources such as DA BUX, SNAP-Ed, housing assistance and more.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RELIEF: Hawai'i Foodbank built upon its partnership with the City and County of Honolulu's Department of Emergency Management (DEM) by signing a Memorandum of Understanding with DEM that **designates Hawai'i Foodbank as their lead agency for emergency feeding before, during and after a disaster.**



BUILDING *connections* TO ‘ĀINA

As we gather food from around us, Hawai‘i Foodbank holds a responsibility to cultivate and reciprocate the nourishment we receive. Initiatives like our Farm to Foodbank program and a newly piloted composting program empower us to build our connections – among ‘āina, ‘ohana, thriving communities and a sustainable future.

Last year, the Farm to Foodbank program supported more than 20 local farmers, farm hubs and producers by purchasing nearly \$3 million of local produce. This provided nearly 2 million pounds of healthy, nutritious food to local families in need while supporting the local economy and agriculture.

In that same time, Hawai‘i Foodbank partnered with Full Circle Farm and Kahumanu Organic Farms, diverting more than 120,000 pounds of food waste to pig farmers and composters – helping to keep as much food out of the waste stream as possible.



Remembering ‘INIKI

It has been 30 years since Hurricane ‘Iniki devastated Kaua‘i. It was the costliest and most powerful storm to hit Hawai‘i in modern history. The memories of the storm remain fresh – but the lessons reshaped the way we think about hurricanes and how we prepare for emergencies.

Hawai‘i Foodbank’s ‘Iniki relief efforts garnered national attention and set a model for food bank disaster relief across the country. This laid the groundwork for Hawai‘i Foodbank to work with America’s Second Harvest – now known as Feeding America – in establishing food banks as legitimate and necessary partners in emergency food distribution at both the local and state levels. The response to ‘Iniki has also resulted in lasting relationships between Hawai‘i Foodbank and the County of Kaua‘i, the State of Hawai‘i, FEMA and the National Guard.

NOURISHING *Kaua'i* AND WORKING TO END HUNGER

With the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic and rising inflation rates, hunger on Kaua'i persists at some of its highest levels in the last century. An entirely new level of need exists on the Garden Island, and – as we learned from previous disasters like Hurricane 'Iniki – the recovery can take years. **More than 12,000 Kaua'i residents continue to struggle with hunger**, and this includes 1 in 4 keiki.

In 2022, Hawai'i Foodbank Kaua'i and its network of nearly 40 agency partners continued working together to ensure families, keiki, kūpuna and individuals facing hunger received the food they needed during this difficult time. Over the last year, Hawai'i Foodbank Kaua'i:

- Distributed **food for 1.2 million meals**, including nearly 150,000 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Stocked **11 School Pantries** to provide young

students with after-school snacks and supplemental food bags to take home to their families.

- Provided \$50 vouchers to **more than 2,300 low-income seniors** to purchase fresh produce at farmers' markets.
- Launched new programs like the **Farm to Foodbank** produce purchase program and **Kūpuna Fresh**, demonstrating our commitment to providing more nutritious, locally sourced food to the communities we serve.

Looking ahead, Hawai'i Foodbank Kaua'i will continue working diligently to strengthen its feeding programs, build and nurture community partnerships, and find ways to sustainably plan for the future – all while continuing to respond to the immediate, ongoing needs of communities throughout the Garden Island.

Nearly every day of the year, our Hawai'i Foodbank **volunteers play a vital role in the flow of food** that comes through our warehouses. Inside the warehouse, volunteers inspect dry food and produce donations by checking the integrity of food products, sorting categories and boxing items for warehouse storage. This helps prepare food for distribution, so we can get it more efficiently to those in need. Warehouse volunteers also provide important administrative and clerical assistance. Beyond our warehouse walls, volunteers provide valuable support to our agency partners and assist with special projects and year-round events.

Last year, **our dedicated volunteers on O'ahu and Kaua'i worked 6,822 shifts.** The value of their time and energy would be comparable to hiring nearly a dozen additional full-time staff members. This steadfast support allows Hawai'i Foodbank to focus more resources directly on its operations and program support.
